2. TEXT OF PETITION

3. ACTION TAKEN TO RESOLVE ISSUES OF CONCERN BEFORE SUBMITTING THE PETITION

According to the petition already on the web with complaints made towards the SPSO, there is no one held to account regarding this organisation. The SPSO are their own boss, due to my illness which has held me back from writing to all MSPs with my serious complaint regarding SPSO, I had written to Mr John Scott, the Ayr MSP, asking him to recover information I had requested from the SPSO, before they closed my file on me, concerning the Council I had complained about.

I petitioned Parliament with my concerns towards North Ayrshire Council, concerning their treatment, towards me relating to a unlawful planning application, and how negligent both North Ayrshire Council and involving certain planning officials into disrepute within the Scottish Government offices.
